- Question Paper will comprise of Competency Based Questions (MCQs, Case Based, Source Based Integrated Questions, Crosswords or any other similar types), Objective Type Questions, Short and Long Answer Type Questions.
- Co- Scholastic areas will be given grades as per the student's performance during the class.
- No Retest will be taken in any of the Pen and Paper Test. In case of illness, an application along with medical certificate must be submitted within three days of the exam. In such case, the student will be marked ML. In case of any willful absence from the exam, the student will be marked Absent (AB).
- Final Result will be calculated with the cumulative result of Term 1 & Term 2.
- A student must score at least 33% marks in each subject for promotion to the next class.
- Essential Repeat in Class 5 A student of Class 5 who is not eligible for pass or promoted, will be placed in the category of 'Essential Repeat' which means the student will be held back in the same class.
